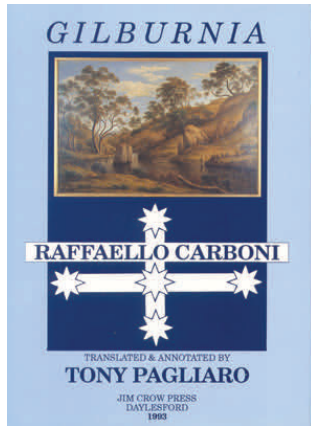

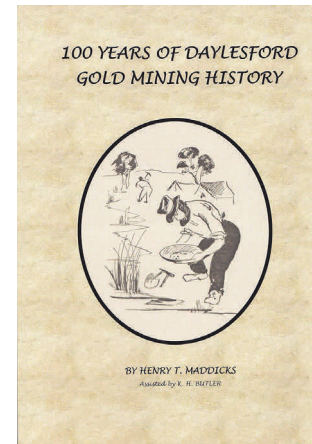

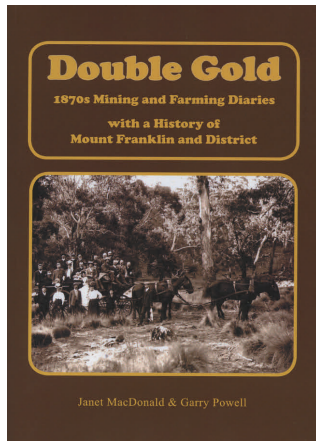
**100 Years of Daylesford Gold Mining History**

The Gervasonis were central figures in the early settlement of Yandoit Creek and to them is due much of the Italian character which is of such interest today.



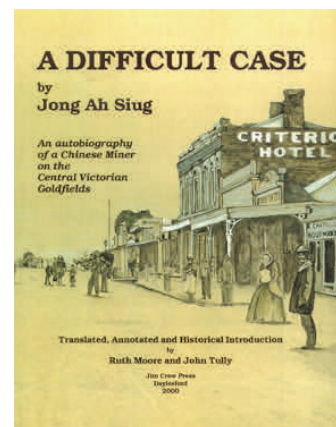
